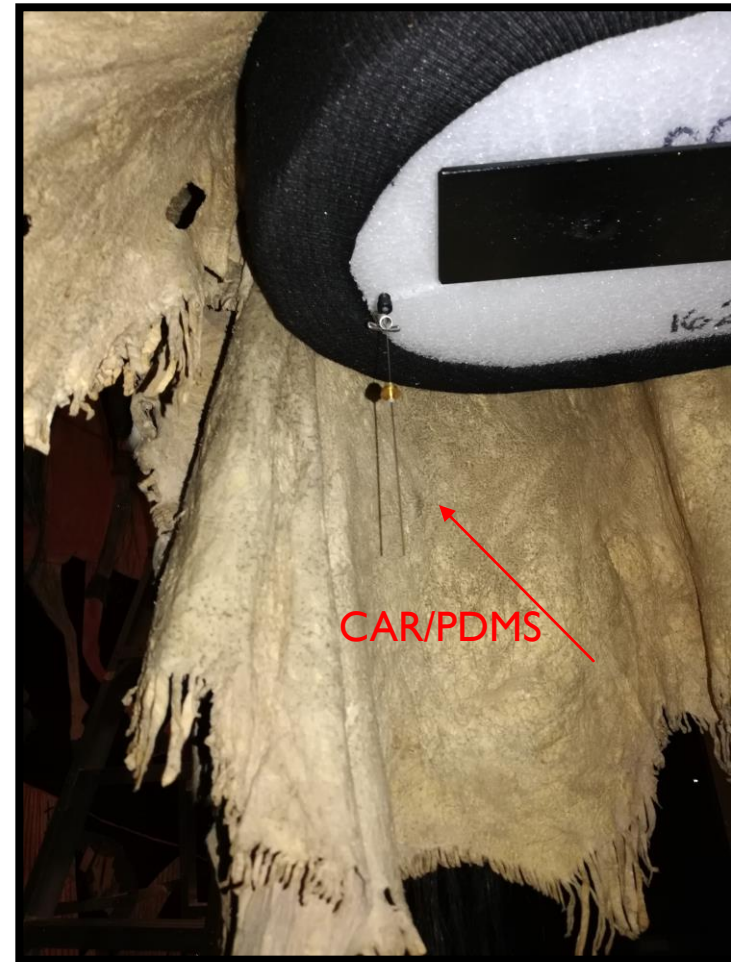
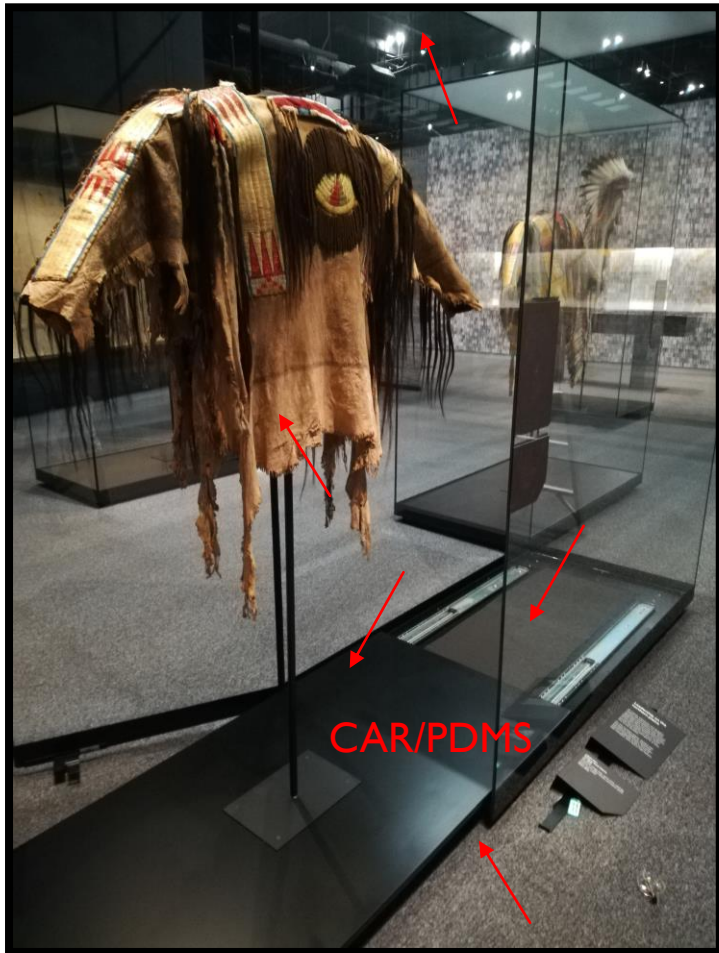


Man's Shirt (009963.000), ca. 1860

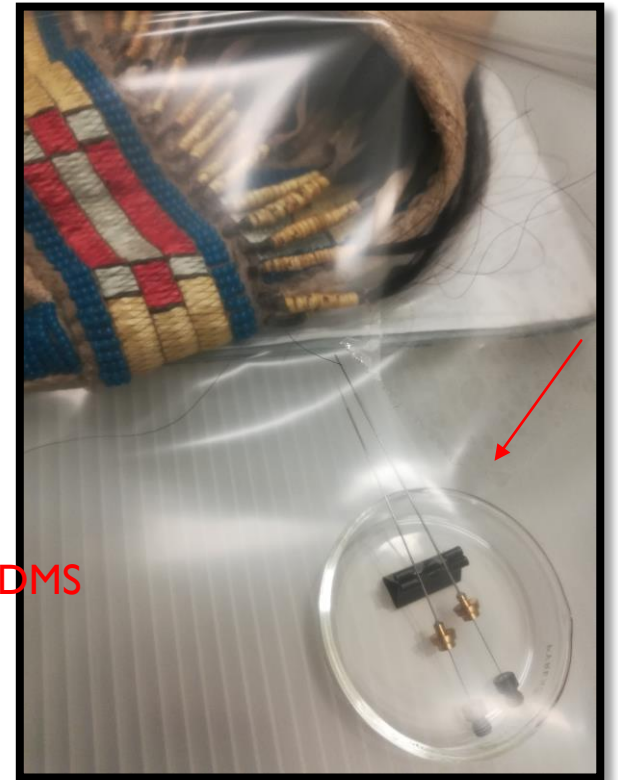

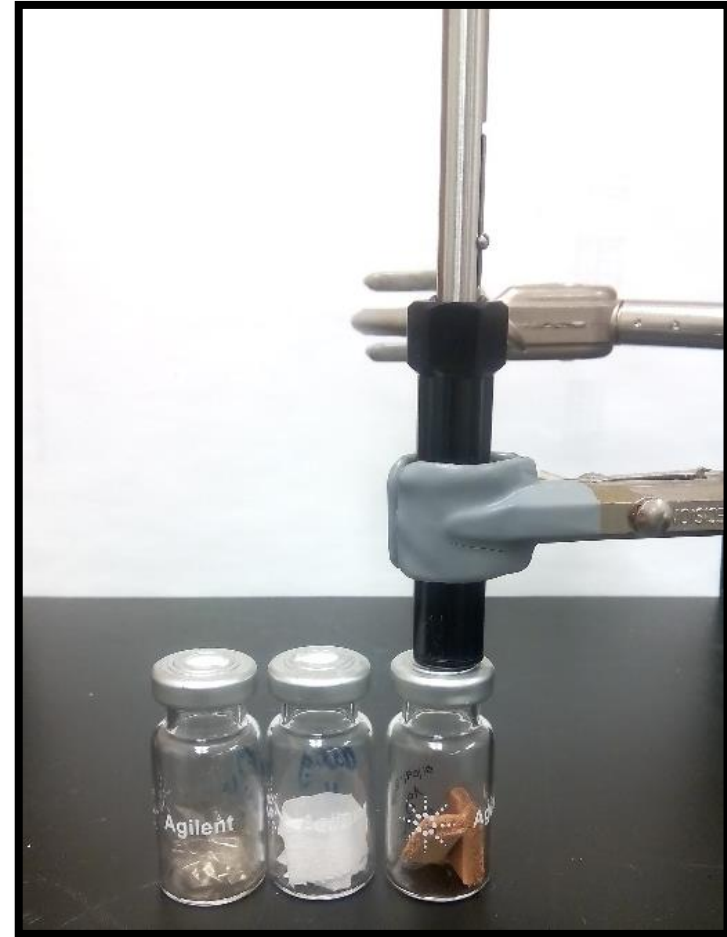

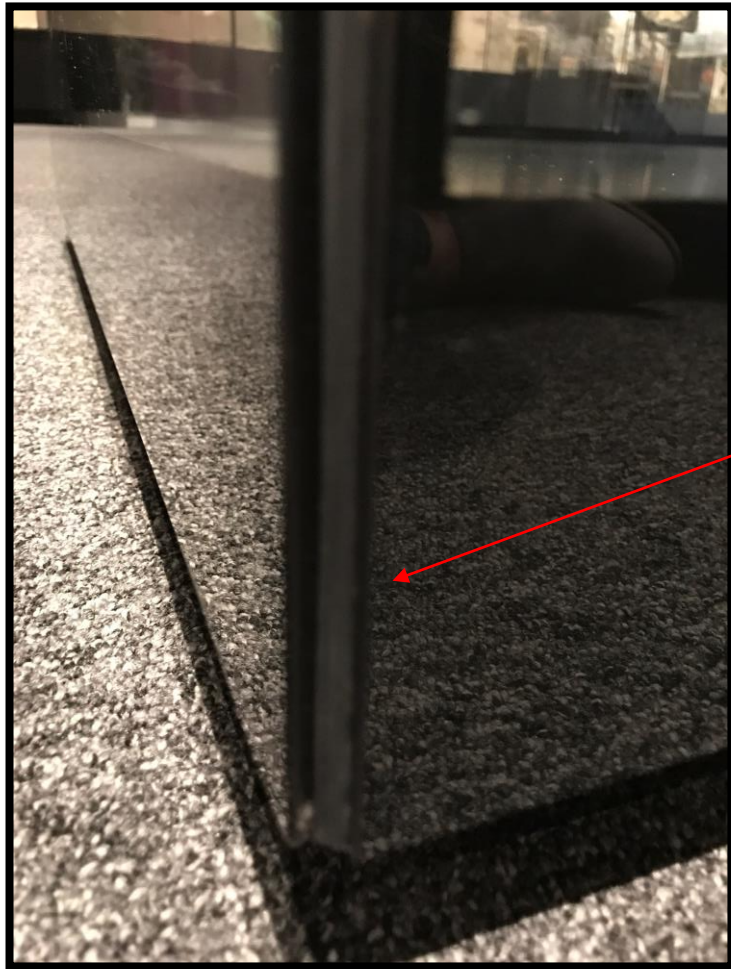
